FNA provides opportunities for the entire family. FNA programs emphasize Alaskan Native culture and heritage. There is now an opportunity to learn the Koyukon language in our Dual Language Classroom.

FNA coordinates with FNSBSD and other programs in the Fairbanks area to help children with special needs (learning disabilities, physical handicaps and/or behavioral challenges). Children who attend FNA programs receive nutritious home-style meals and snacks.
