

Work-Related Injuries


Do you know what steps you or a fellow staff member need to take after an injury while working?

- 1) Make sure the scene is safe, provide CPR or First Aid if necessary.
If serious or life-threatening call 911 immediately.

- 2) For staff injuries,
call Alaska National Medcor at 1-800-553-8041.

A triage nurse will answer the call and give you further instructions and will also begin the paperwork, which is forwarded to FNA's Health & Safety Coordinator.

- 3) The injured staff, as well as any witnesses need to fill out an incident report as soon as possible.



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- 4) You have **30 days to disclose a work-related injury** to FNA. Once FNA has been notified you have **5 days to complete and submit** the Employee Report of Occupational Health or Injury to Employer Form.
