Leehaanh = You stand up.

Leedo = You sit down.

Nelo' etonlaah = You wash your hands.

Hesote hoonlaanh = You clean up.

Nelo hetonlaah = You brush your teeth.

Neelkk'e neenϕhdaał = You all line up.

Baasee' = Thank you.

Neelggenea' ts'eelaanh = We are friends.

Genee gonee? = What is this?

Baav kk'aadee? = Are you hungry?

Nok'esodon' = We will eat.

K'eztolee = We will sing.

Tl'oo kk'aat = I want milk.

Tl'oo nedaa' = Pass the milk.

De'aak nedeelkooł = put your coat on.

De'aak deyaaghedeelkooł = Hang up your coat
