FNA Princess Pageant Guidelines

1. Eligibility:

- ◆ Must be between 13-17 years of age
- ◆ Must be a direct descendant of an individual who is Athabascan, Inupiaq, Yup'ik, Unangan, Tlingit, Haida, Tsimshian, Cup'ik, Sugpiaq, Eyak and/or Alaska Native/American Indian
- ◆ Must have documentation of blood quantum or tribal enrollment (attach a copy)

2. Regalia:

A written description of contestant's Native outfit is required and is a key piece to sharing how amazing it is with the judges. The description should include:

- ◆ Type of material used
- ◆ Type of Native regalia
- ◆ Maker(s) of the regalia
- ◆ Any special meaning of the regalia

3. Presentation:

Contestants will be presented to the audience/judges one at a time by an escort. The escort may be the parent or anyone the parent(s) designate.

4. Judging:

Contestants will be judged on their traditional Native regalia only.

5. Deadline

Applications need to be submitted to FNA Administration by Wednesday, March 8, 2023.

6. Place and Date of the event:

FNA Pageants to be held during our Annual Potlatch Saturday, March 18, 2023 at 5 p.m., at the Chief David Salmon Tribal Hall.
